If you are to be married elsewhere, please supply the following details – we have to ask about these things because the law requires the Church of England to do so.

We are now also required to ask you to bring your passports to the church for a short meeting

If either of you are not UK or European Economic Area citizens, it may be that the procedure will need to be different and rather than being published by banns will be by Common Licence. This may involve completing a short questionnaire and providing evidence of residence.

Please attend as many of these readings as you can. The statutory fee for reading the banns and providing the banns certificate (which you must show to the priest marrying you) is **£40.00**. Please make out a cheque for that amount payable to St Andrew's PCC and hand it in with this form.
