Thursday 10th May (Ascension Day) to Sunday 20th May (Pentecost) 'Thy Kingdom Come'

We're now right in the middle of the nine-day period between Ascension Day and Pentecost which has been designated a prayer 'Novena' – creating a wave of prayer by Christians all over the world.

Last week you were given 2 luggage labels with room to write the names of 5 people you commit to pray for.

These may be godchildren, friends, family members – whoever you would like to pray for specifically over this 9-day period – that they come to know and follow Jesus. There's one label to hang on the prayer tree, and one to take home and remind you to pray each day.
